### 国际预科生项目简介

国际预科生项目是上海交通大学终身教育学院面向国际学生设置的本科学前预备教育非学历项目。预科项目针对国际学生特点量身定制，国际学生可根据需要，在语言、专业及跨文化沟通能力上得到提升，为未来的大学学习打下扎实的基础。

#### 国际预科生项目包含：

**项目 A：** 招生对象为有较好汉语基础（HSK 4  $\geq$  180 或同等汉语水平）、需要进一步提高汉语、英语、数学等学科水平的国际学生。

**项目 B：** 针对无汉语基础或汉语基础薄弱但其他学科成绩较好的国际学生进行汉语培训，同时也帮助学生在数学、英语等学术能力方面得到提高。此项目为 Extension Program，不涉及学历、学位等事宜，仅为学生自愿参加的学术课程学习。

### 申请资格

1. 高中毕业及以上学历。
2. 持外国有效护照的非中国籍公民，并符合教育部《关于规范我高等学校接受国际学生有关工作的通知》（教外函〔2020〕12号）等相关规定。
3. 身心健康。
4. 入学前年满 17 周岁，且不超过 23 周岁。

### 申请材料：

1. 高中毕业及以上学历证明。应届毕业生可先提供由所在高中开具的预毕业证明。
2. 高中简介，需中文或英文（如学校整体情况、入学要求、录取情况、课程体系、高中成绩评分制度、升学情况等）。
3. 护照信息页（有效期大于 6 个月）及护照尺寸照片 2 张。
4. 自述信，需中文或英文（本人签字，内容包括但不限于个人背景、爱好特长、申请原因与学习规划）。
5. 推荐信一封，需中文或英文（推荐人需签字并提供联系方式）。
6. 学业水平证明（包括但不限于）：

6.1 由所在高中出具的成绩单（含高中阶段所有课程）。

6.2 所在国家或地区统一高中毕业考试或大学入学考试成绩，如 SAT/ACT/IB/A-Level/UEC 等。如申请时无法取得上述考试成绩，须提供情况说明。

7. 获奖证书及其他支撑性材料

8. 申请项目 A 的学生需提供近一年内获得的 HSK4 级 180 分（或以上）成绩证书或同等资格证明。
9. 截止 22 年 9 月 1 日未满 18 周岁的申请人，提供在华监护人保证书（需公证）。
10. 父母双方或一方为中国公民的申请人，提供以下证明材料：
  - 10.1 申请人出生即获得外国国籍的证明，或后加入外国国籍的证明。
  - 10.2 申请人父母双方国籍或户籍证明（护照或身份证）。
  - 10.3 申请人出生即获得外国国籍的，①如父母双方或一方为中国公民且有国外永久居留，提供相应的永久居留证明；②如父母双方或一方为中国公民但未获得国外永久居留，提供申请人退出中国国籍的证明。
  - 10.4 申请人原为中国公民后加入外国国籍的，提供注销原中国户籍证明及退出中国国籍的证明。
  - 10.5 申请人 2018 年 4 月 30 日（含）至申请时出入中国的护照签章页。

注：① 以上所有申请材料若非中文或英文，须提供经公证后的中文或英文翻译件。

② 申请阶段无需邮寄纸质申请材料。

## 申请流程

1. 登录 [elearning.sjtu.edu.cn/register](http://elearning.sjtu.edu.cn/register)，按提示注册账号，进入网申系统。
2. 按系统要求填写报名表并上传申请材料。
3. 支付申请费：人民币 800 元。
4. 招生录取采用材料审核制，将根据学生情况评定是否安排面试。

5. 获得项目预录取资格的学生在规定时间内按提示在网申系统支付全额学费。
6. 缴费成功的学生，将收到正式录取资料。
7. 学生持学生签证按照录取通知书规定的时间和地点报到注册。

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# 2022 Pre-University Program for International Students

## Introduction

Pre-University Program of Lifelong Education College, SJTU is a non-degree program designed for international students to enhance their language skills, academic performance, and cultural adaptability. The students can thus lay a solid foundation for their further undergraduate study.

Pre-University Program consists of:

**Program A:** This program is designed for students who have already reached a good level of Chinese language proficiency (HSK 4  $\geq$  180 or equivalent) but need remediation of academic subjects of Chinese, English and Mathematics to meet the requirements of SJTU undergraduate admissions.

**Program B:** This program is suitable for students who possess limited or no Chinese language skills but perform well in other subjects. Students are given intensive Chinese language training. They can also make further progress in English, Mathematics and other subjects to meet the requirements of SJTU undergraduate admissions.

The above program is an extension program, not related to any credit or degree. It is an academic course that is taken by students voluntarily.

## Eligibility

1. Graduates of senior high school (or above)
2. Non-Chinese citizens who hold a foreign passport and comply with the relevant regulations set by the "Document No. 12 (2020) of Ministry of Education of the PRC" and etc.
3. Students who are physically and mentally healthy
4. Students who are aged between 17 and 23 before registration

## Curriculum

### Program A:

Registration will start in September, 2022 (the specific time will be informed on the admission notice). Two semesters in one school year will last for 28 weeks in total with 18 weeks in the first semester and 10 weeks in the second semester.

1. The curriculum is subject to changes according to requirements for further studies as well as students' academic achievements.

2. All subjects except for English and Chinese are taught in Chinese.

3. Chinese Writing and Chinese Presentation Skills are optional courses for students who are planning to choose liberal arts majors; Physics and Chemistry are for those who are planning to choose science majors; Introduction to Computer Programming and Intelligence is optional for both liberal arts and science students. Students are supposed to take at least 2 of the optional courses above.

## Application Documents and Fees

### Application Materials

- Senior high school diploma or equivalent (2022 graduating students should provide an official statement from your high school as proof of graduation);
- School Profile (e.g. Overall Introduction, Admission Requirement, Enrollment Rate, Curriculum, Grading System, University Acceptance of Graduates and etc.)
- Passport information page (valid for more than 6 months) and photo of the same size as the one in passport
- Personal statement in Chinese or English (with signature, contents should include but not limited to personal background, hobbies and expertise, reasons for applying the program and study plan);
- One recommendation letter in Chinese or English (with signature and contact information);
- Academic certificate (including but not limited to):
  - High school official transcripts, including all courses taken.
  - Test scores of the national high school graduation exam or college entrance exam in the country or region, such as SAT/ACT/IB/A-level/UEC, etc. If the above test results cannot be obtained at the time of application, an explanation must be provided.
- Award certificates (if any) and other supportive materials required by SJTU.

Besides, applicants should submit the following documents if they are

- Program A candidate:
  - HSK examination score report (level 4 or above) or equivalent certificate
  - Applicants under 18 years old (until September 1, 2022) should provide a letter of guarantee signed by their guardian in China (should be notarized by relevant authorities).
- Applicants whose one or both parents are Chinese citizens should provide the following materials:
  - Certificate of the applicant obtained foreign nationality at birth or afterward.
  - The nationality or household registration certificate of both the applicant's parents (passport or ID card).
  - For applicants who obtained foreign nationality at birth, ① if one or both of the parents are Chinese citizens with permanent residence abroad, certificate of the corresponding permanent residence needs to be provided; ② if one or both of the parents are Chinese citizens without permanent residence abroad, certificate of the withdrawal from Chinese nationality of the applicant needs to be provided.
  - For applicants who were originally Chinese citizens and obtained foreign nationalities afterward, a certificate for the cancellation of their original registered residence in China and the renunciation of the Chinese nationality should be provided.
  - The entry and exit seal page of visiting China on the applicant's passport from April 30, 2018 to the time of application.

Note:

- If any of the above application materials are not in Chinese or English, a notarized translation in Chinese or English shall be provided.
- There is no need to mail hard copies of supporting materials during application.

### Application Fee (Non-refundable)

CNY 800 (approx. USD 120, pay online)

Note: Whether the applicant is admitted or not, his or her application fee will not be returned.

## Application Procedures

- Visit [elearning.sjtu.edu.cn/register](http://elearning.sjtu.edu.cn/register), register a new account according to the instruction, and then login to the online application system;
- Complete the application form and submit the application materials according to the instructions in the system;
- Pay the application fee of CNY 800;
- The admission decision is based on application material evaluation and integrative test if necessary;

- The applicant who gets admitted will need to pay the full tuition fee in the application system within time limit;
- The eligible applicant will receive official admission documents;
- The Applicant should apply for student visa and come to SJTU to register at the required location within time limit.
