

UIC's campus is located next to the ancient Huitong Village. Surrounding the campus and the village are many coffee shops, restaurants, and other interesting little shops. The campus itself is a modern complex that hasdormitories on-site. International students will have the chance to share a room with a Chinese student thereby enabling them to learn much more about this complex and beautiful culture-first-hand! All rooms are equipped with en-suite bathrooms, LAN, and separately controlled air conditioning. Each floor of the dormitories has a small pantry and kitchenette, with a common lounge providing space to relax with friends after a long day. A multi-purpose room, study room,and laundry area complete the suite of services available to all students living in dormitories.





The second-phase campus will mainly be the home of science programmes and Graduate School. The building area of approximately 400,000 square meters will host the bases of science, engineering, interdisciplinary subjects, cutting-edge technologies and industrial transformation. The project is expected to be fully put into use in September 2025.

Make sure to prepare the following supporting documents before application:

- Graduate Certification of High School
- Transcripts
- Recommendation Letter
- Personal Statement
- Financial Statement
- Copy of Passport
- Application Form for Scholarship(if needed)
- English Language Certification: e.g. TOEFL: Internet-based test (iBT) - Score: 79; or Paper-delivered test - a sum score of 60; or IELTS Academic: Overall Band: 6.0; or Other English language qualifications deemed acceptable by the University
